Dice prayers

Find any dice you might have kicking around in your house, perhaps borrow some from a board game. Take turns rolling the dice and pray like this (you can decide between you if prayers are to be spoken out loud, thought silently, drawn, or a mix!):

- ▣ Thank God for something in your life.
- ▣ Pray for something that you need.
- ▣ Praise God for something that he is.
- ▣ Pray for someone in your family.
- ▣ Thank God for something in creation
- ▣ Pray for a need outside of you or your family.

We sometimes end prayers with the word "Amen", which is a Hebrew word from the Bible, meaning something like "so be it" or "that's right!". Why don't you end with a big Amen?
