NOVEMBER 2021

'You are holy, enthroned on the praises of Israel. In you our fathers trusted; they trusted, and you delivered them. To you they cried and were rescued; in you they trusted and were not put to shame.' (Psalm 22v3-5)

1 SPAIN, Ciudad Real - Matt & Judith Hill: 'Following the Passion for the Gospel conference at the end of October, pray for Editorial Peregrino as we send out individual copies of *Getting Back in the Race* (Joel Beeke) to the first 500 registered attendees.'

2 UK, HQ - Church Partnership Coordinator, Martin Tatham: 'Please pray for preparation for both conference and deputation visits, and as the missionaries on deputation spend time with churches around the UK, that this will lead to strengthened relationships, and greater partnership in the gospel.'

3 ROMANIA, Târgu Mureş - Sándor & Napsugár Kelemen: 'Just over a week ago we had a baptismal service where 4 young people were baptised; 3 young ladies and one young man, all from our church. Our Sára was one of those being baptised! We rejoice in the grace of God we see in her life and indeed in the life of all these young people.'

4 GERMANY, Utzenfeld - Tim & Deb Brooks: Tim & Deb's daughter, Esther, asks for prayer: 'Please pray for my friend at school, Isabelle, whose grandmother is dying. As far as I know, her grandmother is not a believer and Isabelle definitely isn't. Isabelle is reasonably open to talking about Christian things as she came to my baptism.' Pray that Esther would be helped in conversations with Isabelle and that she would be able to share how Jesus

is our hope in life and death. Pray that both Isabelle and her grandmother would come to true faith in Christ at this difficult time.

5 POLAND, Włocławek - Krzysztof & Aneta Rutkowsky: 'We are grateful to the Lord for publishing by Legatio the translation of *Who Made God?* by Edgar Andrews in the Polish language. Pray that this book may help in the debate with the atheists and those who struggle with the question of science allegedly erasing the existence of God.'

6 UK, HQ - Mission Director, Andrew Birch: 'Pray for today's EMF conference in Preston. Pray for the preaching of God's Word, for the EMF missionaries who will be taking part, for the fellowship between those attending, and that the Lord will use the conference to help us all to grow in faithfulness as we evangelise in an increasingly hostile world.'

7 FRANCE, Marseille - Richard & Barbara: 'Zoe has had very poor health needing dialysis three times weekly. After seven years' waiting, a kidney transplant was found in September. The operation seems to have gone well. Pray she will enjoy better health and with God's blessing, and will have a desire to make progress with the literacy and understand God's word when Barbara resumes weekly visits.'

- 8 UK, Hungarian Reformed Church in London - István & Tünde Salánki:** Over the half term holiday we visited Tunde's parents in Hungary. Her Dad is frail and her mum struggles to look after him. Please pray for wisdom how to help them best. Please, continue to pray for the effects of ULEZ which from 25th October, London's Ultra Low Emission Zone means a daily charge of £12.50 for older cars. It affects a great number of our congregation. We fear that this may result in lower attendance. Please pray that this would not be the case.
- 9 GREECE, Ioannina - Leonidas & Irene Kollaros:** 'We plan to have a seminary in church in November in which a brief summary on Bible history will be presented in video form in 13 sessions. It is intended to give Christians a better understanding of the development of the history of redemption. It is also good for training Christians how to evangelise Muslim immigrants of whom there are plenty in Greece and some of them seem to be interested in the gospel. This project will be undertaken with the help of some Christians from Germany.'
- 10 ROMANIA, Boghis - Benjamin & Debora Pap:** 'In October I began a study meeting in Boghis, as well as in Simleu based on the book of Desiring God by John Piper. Please, pray that God will bless those who attend this study.'
- 11 GREECE, Thessaloniki - Antonis & Vicki Topaloglou:** 'Pray for our family health condition as we are entering a season of cold etc. We are praying for resources in order to finish the work in the Ramoth building.'
- 12 POLAND, Zywiec - Dawid & Agnieszka Koziot:** 'Please pray for Wieslaw. He is a Pole, a six-year-old man who lives and works in London. A few weeks ago, he visited our church that he knew from the Internet. He is currently in London but is still online with us. Pray that he will understand the gospel and stay in touch with us.'
- 13 GERMANY, Utzenfeld - Tim & Deb Brooks:** 'We have started doing a Christianity Explored course with Daniela and Susanne. Please pray for Susanne, who wants to know what it means to have a relationship with Jesus.'
- 14 UK, Hungarian Reformed Church in London - István & Tünde Salánki:** 'Please pray that those who attended the Baby Conference in October may come to church too to listen to God's Word preached. We invited them to a follow-up event on 14th November that would focus on marriage.'
- 15 UK, HQ:** Please remember in prayer the prayer meetings we are starting to hold every two months for our retired missionaries. The first one will be on 15th November. Pray for all those who are able to attend that they would be really blessed in their walk with the Lord and encouraged with the fellowship together.

It was a happy occasion to reflect upon the service of giving thanks to God and having after church fellowship. The registry of our church by the government has been completed.'
- 18 POLAND, Zywiec - Dawid & Agnieszka Koziot:** 'Please pray for Joanna. She was baptized in September but her husband prevents her from attending services, threatens to divorce her, and puts pressure on her. Pray that she would remain in the Lord and that her husband would change his attitude towards her.'
- 19 UK - T & L:** 'We're making friends through new ladies coming to Sharing Skills and other families who have adopted. We're also helping and supporting five men working at a local hospital who've moved here from the Middle East. Please pray for wisdom in building relationships with everyone and their families.'
- 20 UK, HQ - Northern Ireland Representative, Phil Dunn:** 'Please pray for our Belfast conference which is being held on Saturday 20th November in Stranmillis Evangelical Presbyterian Church (from 10am - 1.30pm). This will be our first in-person conference in over a year and a half. Please pray we will be able to get to know them and their families. Please pray too for our church as we try to become more outward looking again after the period of the pandemic. May the Lord use us all as his witnesses where he has put us. We would love to see new people coming to Christ! Please pray for a lady who has attended a couple of times recently.'
