5. Please continue to **pray** for the recruitment of the right person to join us in managing the opportunities to engage with Social Media and reach out to a wider audience. We need a young person with experience. **Pray** also that our search for new trustees to strengthen and enhance the internal structures of the ministry will be worthwhile.
6. In the next few weeks we will be making applications for funding to some of the largest Christian trusts in the land. We have worked on the supporting documents and clarified our areas of need which translates into ten's of thousands of pounds. **Pray** for those who will apply on our behalf, (experts in this area), that they would represent us well and that potential donors would be generous towards us.
7. As a team, (in our daily tp work), that we don't lose sight of the depth of compassion in God's heart for those who don't know him. Sometimes when we are making calls, or working on a document or doing research it's easy to feel removed from the desperation some people feel because they have lost their way. **Pray** that we will carry the compassion of Jesus into everything we do in the name of trypraying.
